

# Philippine National Costumes



**Baro't Saya** is a collarless blouse and skirt which means baro at saya (*blouse and skirt*). From the original, half-naked style, the bare upper torso was slowly covered with a short-sleeved, collarless blouse called "baro". It is the national dress for women in the Philippines.

**Barong Tagalog**, more commonly known simply as barong (*and occasionally baro*), is an embroidered long-sleeved formal shirt for men and a national dress for men in the Philippines.

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
